Challenges for Prayer

The church in Benin is desperate for discipleship. There is a shortfall of change pastors able to meet the needs of the growing Christian population, nor are there enough new leaders been produced. Developing well-trained, biblically illiterate, and holy living leaders in disciples will enable the shift from synchronized Church to sanctified bride.

Animism is a powerful force in Benin. Although Christianity is poised to numerically take over ethnic religions in the near future, far too many Christians have a syncretized compromised faith that sees them in church on Sunday and consulting the witch doctor during the week. Pray for revival that purifies the Church and sees Christians honoring God alone. Pray also for many witch doctors to experience the power of Jesus and turn to Him.

Bible translation remains a pressing need. Nearly half of Benin's languages are without a Bible or even a new testament. There's also a great need for other literature to be translated. Pray that this might help the Church become more biblically literate.

We will, upon moving from this place, quickly unite with another gospel-preaching church where we can carry out the spirit of this covenant and the principles of God's Word.
